**Directions**

All events are in the vicinity of the OU campus, accessible from I-35 via exits for Lindsey St. (coming from the south) or Main St. (coming from the north). See map for location of conference events. We will give you a map to the powwow in your registration packets.

On Friday April 16 from 7-9 p.m. we will meet for our opening reception at the Jacobson House Native Art Center, 609 Chautauqua Avenue (on the corner of Boyd and Chautauqua, near the northwest edge of OU campus; see map letter A). The best place to park is in a campus lot on the corner of Cruce and College (see map letter B).

On Saturday April 17, the SEM-SP conference will be held at the University of Oklahoma School of Music, 500 West Boyd (corner of Boyd and Elm; see map letter D). There is a parking garage on Elm adjacent to the School of Music which is free on weekends (see map letter C).

On Saturday April 17 at 7 p.m., the OU Spring Powwow will be held at Lloyd Noble Center, 2900 Jenkins Ave. (south of campus but not within easy walking distance). From the School of Music, turn left on Boyd, then left on Chautauqua. Continue 1.5 miles, then turn left on Imhoff Road. The Lloyd Noble Center will be on your right, surrounded by an enormous parking lot.
